High in size (110-120 cm), with a very thin stem, is well suited for affiliated cultivation with cereals (triticale, celery, oats, wheat for biomass) and with forage grasses.

Santhal has a remarkable retreat speed, is very resistant to calving by cattle. It is suitable for grazing, for the production of green fodder and for hay.
